Chester Mystery Plays 2008 is staged in two parts, **The Prophecy** and **The Fulfilment**. Each part is ticketed separately and is a complete performance in its own right.

Staged in the open air against the backdrop of Chester Cathedral, performances are every evening (except Sundays) at 7.30pm, plus a matinee at 1pm on Saturdays. Both parts may be seen every Saturday. There are no performances on Sundays.

The audience is seated under covered stands with stepped aisle access. All seats are numbered and there is disabled access to the front row.

Performances are of approx three hours' duration, including one interval. Bar and toilet facilities available.

THE PROPHECY begins with the Creation of the World with Adam and Eve and ends with the Nativity and formative years of Christ, the Child.

June 26 (preview), 28 (matinee), 30, July 2, 4, 5 (mat), 8, 10, 12 (mat), 14, 16, 18, 19 (mat).

THE FULFILMENT continues the life of Jesus to the Crucifixion and ends with the Last Judgement.

June 27 (preview), 28 (evening), July 1, 3, 5 (eve), 7, 9, 11, 12 (eve), 15, 17, 19 (eve).

A LITTLE BACKGROUND...

These earthy moving plays were first performed on open waggons by Chester guildsmen in the 1300s. Few medieval towns were able to afford to do this and original texts survive from only five English cities, Chester's being the most complete in existence.

Chester's cycle was also the longest-running as it was the last place to succumb to an ecclesiastical ban in the 1500s, much to the fury of the ruling archbishop. The Plays were officially revived for the Festival of Britain in 1951, after which Chester Mystery Plays Ltd was established as a registered charity, committed to ensuring the continued production of the Plays.
